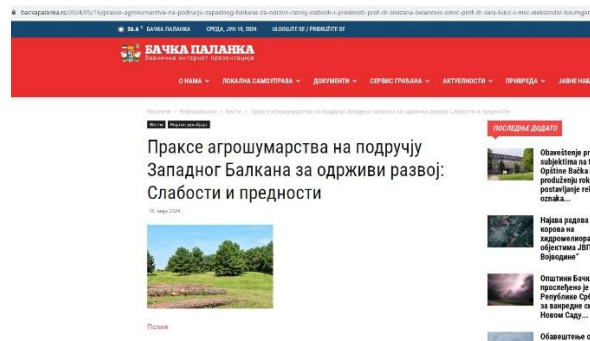

The event was announced on the official website of the municipality of Backa Palanka.



On June 5<sup>th</sup> 2024 a workshop for the local community was organized in the Municipality of Bačka Palanka building. The workshop consisted of three presentations held by Sara Lukić, Snežana Belanović Simić and Aleksandar Baumgertel from the University of Belgrade Faculty of Forestry.

The first presentation entitled: "Field shelterbelts in agriculture – a step towards agroforestry was presented by Sara Lukić. In this presentation the audience was introduced to the agroforestry systems in Serbia, pointing out the potentials and benefits of field shelterbelts in agriculture production systems. The recorded state and effects of the shelterbelts in the area of Bačka Palanka was presented it as a part of AGFORWEB activity, which is a significant effort to define the agroforestry system as a good practice in land management. The audience met with the concept of agroforestry, and gained insight into the project's aims to contribute to the achievement of key objectives of the EU Common Agricultural Policy 2023-27, including mitigating climate change, caring for the environment, preserving landscapes and biodiversity, revitalizing rural areas and protecting food quality and health.

Next presentation entitled: "The influence of forest protective belts on the condition of the soil" was presented by Snežana Belnović Simić. She provided insight into the agroforestry-soil connection, as well as the importance of agroforestry integration for sustainable development.

The final presentation presented by Aleksandar Bumgertel was related to the possibilities of financing the establishment of protective forest belts and access to funds.

The lecturers shared their professional knowledge and experience in this area.

The workshop ended with discussion and questions after the lectures at 13:20h.
