On 19th of March 2024 a workshop for the local community was organized in Oprisavci. The AGFORWEB project was presented by a lecture held by Vladimir Margeta from the Faculty of Agrobiotechnical Sciences Osijek. At the workshop 32 participants from family farms and governmental institutions were present. Promotional material was handed together with the questionnaire to all of the participants.

'Agroforestry in practice: representative examples of agroforestry in eastern Croatia', Vladimir Margeta

The aim of the lecture was to introduce the participants to the basics of agroforestry, to answer the question of what agroforestry is, what are the most common types of agroforestry, and what representative examples can be seen in the area of eastern Croatia. One type of agroforestry was presented:

silvo-pastoral with a few of the most important examples that were found in the area of eastern Croatia.

The lecture lasted 45 minutes, with 30 minutes of questions and discussion.

During the workshop, the questionnaire was handed to the participants and 21 questionnaires were completed for evaluation. The workshop was part of the annual meeting of pig breeders.
